SQUADS · ONE CAMP

Each squad: 1 Captain · 1 2iC · 2+ Coaches / Head Coaches. Know your men by name before Friday.

KEY MOMENTS: BE THE KEY VOICE FOR YOUR SQUAD

WELCOME MOMENT FRI · 4PM Host the arrival. Greet every man into the squad by name. The first 10 minutes set the weekend.	MORNING PRAYER SAT · 6AM Gather your squad early. Lead them in, set the tone. Men follow a voice, not a schedule.	TUG O WAR FRI · 7PM Rally the squad. Every man on the rope or on the line cheering. Nobody watches from the edge.
SQUAD GAMES SAT · 6:45AM Captains call it, coaches spur it on. Compete hard, celebrate louder.	FIRESIDE CHATS FRI · 9PM Head Coach leads. Captains draw the quiet men in. This is where connection lands.	SETUP / TEARDOWN FRI 1-4PM · SAT 12:30PM Squads work it together. Shoulder to shoulder is where brothers are made.
